

MINUTES OF ADJOURNED MEETING OF COUNCIL HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER, CITY HALL, MONDAY, OCTOBER 25TH, 1920, AT 9:00 P.M.

From the Canadian Merchants Service Guild, enclosing Agreement in duplicate between the Canadian Merchants Service Guild on behalf of the Masters and Mates, and the City of North Vancouver, said agreement to terminate February 28th, 1921.

Moved by Alderman W.J. Irwin seconded by Alderman Townsley and resolved that the Mayor and Clerk be and they are hereby authorized to sign the above agreement in duplicate, and the Clerk is authorized to attach the Corporate Seal thereto.

From J.G. Farmer, CMC, acknowledging receipt of communication of the 21st instant, with reference to the proposed water works on Lynn Creek.

Moved by Alderman Watson seconded by Alderman T. Irwin and resolved that the above invitation be received, accepted, and acknowledged, and advice forwarded that as many as possible will endeavour to make it convenient to attend on that occasion.

From the City Treasurer, being report of the Ferry Receipts for the month of September; also report of the cost of operation of the ferries for the month of September.

The Clerk submitted a plan for the subdivision of Lots 1 and 2, Block 125, DL 274, corner 5th and Chesterfield, showing lane allowance on the easterly line of Lot 2.

Moved by Alderman T. Irwin seconded by Alderman Pilling and resolved that the above plan of subdivision of Lots 1 and 2, Block 125, DL 274, be approved and the City Engineer authorized to sign said plans for registration.

Moved by Alderman Watson seconded by Alderman McColl and resolved that the clerk be authorized to advertise for sale in one issue of the North Shore Press, a number of

tax sale lots; also house No. 242 Second Street East, advertisement to state that upset price may be obtained from the Clerk on application.

Also that an advertisement be inserted in the Press that the City has a number of tax sale lots for sale, to which title can be given at once.
