

**MINUTES OF ADJOURNED SPECIAL MEETING OF COUNCIL HELD IN THE  
COUNCIL CHAMBER, CITY HALL, TUESDAY, OCTOBER 25<sup>TH</sup>, 1921.**

Moved by Alderman Watson, seconded by Alderman McColl and resolved that this Council do now resolve itself into Committee of the Whole Council and that Mayor Vance be Chairman.

Moved by Alderman Irwin, seconded by Alderman McColl and resolved that whereas a considerable amount of close in, valuable property, has been reverting to the City owing to excessive local improvement charges, this greatly limiting the assessment of the City and accordingly increasing the rate on the remainder,

AND WHEREAS this condition of affairs has been placed before the City Council by the City Auditor who recommended that same be remedied by means of the City assuming a portion of the cost of the old local improvement, excepting sanitary sewers and macadamizing,

BE IT RESOLVED that this Council prepare a Bylaw whereby the City may assume twenty-five per cent (25%) of the original cost of the work set out as per Bylaw schedule attached hereto, amounting to \$115,286.56, to be spread over the period of years set out in said Bylaws, approximately ten years.

Moved by Alderman McColl, seconded by Alderman Irwin, and resolved that the Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized to issue a cheque in the amount of \$10.60 account E.E. Morrison, being Solicitor's special disbursements.

Moved by Alderman Irwin, seconded by Alderman Wm. Morden and resolved that we agree to meet the District council on Thursday evening October 27<sup>th</sup> in the City Hall, at 8 p.m. to discuss new schedule on ferries.

The Clerk reported an application from Mr. Buckley for permission to play football at Boulevard Park on alternative Saturdays.

Moved by Alderman Watson, seconded by Alderman Townsley and resolved that the above application be referred to the Chairman of the Parks Committee to make satisfactory arrangements.

Moved by Alderman Watson, seconded by Alderman G.H. Morden and resolved that Mr. Andrew Wallace be granted a pass on the ferry for himself, car and driver, and that instructions be issued to the Mates on the boats, to make room on the boat on allocations for Mr. Wallace's car.

Moved by Alderman Watson, seconded by Alderman Townsley and resolved that the Council do now adjourn, to reconvene in the Council Chamber, City Hall, on Thursday, October 27<sup>th</sup>, 1921, at 8 p.m.
