

MINUTES OF ADJOURNED MEETING OF COUNCIL HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER, CITY HALL, THURSDAY, OCTOBER 27TH, 1921, AT 8:00 P.M.

Moved by Alderman Irwin, seconded by Alderman Townsley and resolved that this Council do now take a recess to permit a conference between the City and District Councils.

At 10:30 p.m. Mayor Vance resumed the Chair and called the Council to order.

Moved by Alderman G.H. Morden, seconded by Alderman Irwin and resolved that Mayor Vance be authorized to attend a meeting of the Executive of the Union of British Columbia Municipalities at Victoria when such meeting is called, for a conference with the Municipal Committee.

Moved by Alderman Townsley, seconded by Alderman G.H. Morden, and resolved that during the absence of Mayor Vance at Victoria, attending the Executive meeting of the Union of British Columbia Municipalities, Alderman Irwin be and he is hereby appointed Acting Mayor.

A communication was received form Col. McKenzie, Commanding 6th Field Company, C.E., applying for free transportation on the ferry for the men in uniform who are training in the Armoury at North Vancouver, and living in Vancouver, on night per week.

Moved by Alderman Watson, seconded by Alderman McColl and resolved that the Clerk be authorized t5o forward Col McKenzie the required transportation for the men living in Vancouver, training in the Armoury at North Vancouver, one night per week, and that an old issue of tickets be used for this purpose.

A communication was received from Mr. T. Halliday, also account for \$149.50 re proposed new ferry.

Moved by Alderman G.H. Morden, seconded by Alderman Townsley and resolved that Mr. Halliday be asked to name a lump sum for which he will submit report.

At 11:05 p.m. it was moved by Alderman Watson, seconded by Alderman G.H. Morden and resolved that the Council do now adjourn, to reconvene in the Council chamber, City Hall, 4th Street, West, on Friday the 28th day of October instant, at 5 o'clock p.m.
