Certificate of Returning Officer - Result of the Referendum, held on the 12 day of August, 1922

I, RUPERT FOSTER ARCHIBALD, Returning Officer for the City of North Vancouver, do hereby certify that as directed by the Municipal Council of the City of North Vancouver for the year 1922, I caused notices to be published and posted to the effect that the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Vancouver has directed that the following questions be submitted to the Electors by way of a Plebiscite.

“PROVIDED a Contract is let for the construction of a Ferry, which firm do you prefer should be awarded the contract:

Napier & Miller, Ltd., of Scotland, at a price of £43,000, which at present current rate of exchange would be \$193,500.00
Delivered in Burrard Inlet.

Or Wallace Shipbuilding and Dry Dock Co., Ltd., contract price, delivered at North Vancouver, \$229,500.00

Are you in favour of having a Ferry built at the present time?”

and that said questions would be submitted for vote of the Electors at 122 First Street west on Saturday, August 12th, 1922, between the hours of 9 o'clock A.M. and 7 o'clock P.M. and that the said vote of the Electors was taken on the said date, resulting as follows:
