The Council met for the purpose of holding a conference with the School Board with respect to tenders being received for alterations to the North Vancouver Hotel and Central School Building.

A number of tenders were received by the School Board, both bulk tenders and for specific trades, the lowest tender being D.B. Watt, \$6,408.00.

Mr. H.B. Watson, Architect, delivered to the Clerk an amended tender which on motion of Alderman Townsley, seconded by Alderman Martinson, was opened, and being from Mr. D.B. Watt to the effect that in the specification furnished him, he had missed page 7, and that the cost of painting and glazing was not included in his tender of \$6,730.00 submitted to the Council on the 16th instant.

Moved by Alderman Watson, seconded by Alderman Harron and resolved that the original tender of Mr. D.B. Watt, stand as read and that the tender of a local painter, for painting and glazing be considered.

The Council withdrew in order to permit of the Trustees, discussing the various tenders submitted to the Board.

At 10:00 p.m. it was moved by Alderman Watson, seconded by Alderman Townsley and resolved that this meeting of Council do now adjourn. Whereupon the Council adjourned.
