

CERTIFICATE OF RETURNING OFFICER

Result of Municipal By-Election held on the 24th day of March A.D. 1923

I, RUPERT FOSTER ARCHIBALD, Returning Officer for the City of North Vancouver do hereby certify that as directed by the Municipal Council of the City of North Vancouver, for the year 1923, I caused certified copies of Bylaw entitled "The North Vancouver School Debenture Bylaw, 1923" to be published and posted as required by law, together with notices appended thereto, that the said Bylaw would be submitted for a vote of the assent of the Electors at 122 First Street West, on Saturday, March 24th, 1923, between the hours of 9 o'clock a.m. and 7 o'clock p.m., and that the said vote of the Electors was taken on the said day, resulting as follows:
