## MINUTES OF JOINT MEETING OF COUNCILS OF THE CITY AND DISTRICT OF NORTH VANCOUVER, HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER, CITY HALL, SEPTEMBER 17<sup>TH</sup>, 1923.

Moved by Alderman Irwin, seconded by Alderman Bridgman and resolved that the Fire and Light Committee of the City, cooperate with a Committee from the District to negotiate with the B.C. Electric Railway Company Limited, with respect to a proposed amendment to franchise re lighting rate, car fares, cost of lighting extensions, filling in between rails, and letting off passengers on the wrong side.

Moved by Alderman Bridgman, seconded by Alderman Irwin and resolved that Reeve Loutet be Convener of such Joint Committee.

The matter of operation of ambulance was discussed and Mr. Hughes stated that he had submitted an offer to the District Council with respect to charges for ambulance calls within the District of North Vancouver.

The District Council agreed to take the matter up at their first meeting.

Moved by Alderman Bridgman, seconded by Alderman Stoker and resolved that the City and District Engineer submit report with respect to cost of improving Keith Road hill temporarily; also improving Heywood Avenue temporarily.

The Superintendent of Works reported the cost of repairing the crossing at Sutherland Avenue and 10<sup>th</sup> Street, estimated cost \$15.75.

Moved by Alderman Stoker, seconded by Alderman Bridgman and resolved that the above work be authorized, providing the District bears one-half the cost.

Moved by Alderman Bridgman, seconded by Alderman Townsley, and resolved that the City and District Engineers report jointly with respect to improving 29<sup>th</sup> Street East, or otherwise to provide entrance to Tempe Heights.

The Meeting then adjourned.
