Moved by Alderman Irwin, seconded by Alderman Tolmie and resolved that the above Certificate be received and spread on the Minute Book.

Moved by Alderman Tolmie, seconded by Alderman Bridgman and resolved that the Bylaw entitled "The School Extraordinary Loan Bylaw, 1923" be now reconsidered, finally adopted, signed by the Mayor and City Clerk and sealed with the Corporate Seal.

Whereupon the Bylaw was read and reconsidered, finally adopted, signed by the Mayor and Acting city Clerk and sealed with the Corporate Seal; No. 589.

Moved by Alderman Bridgman, seconded by Alderman Tolmie and resolved that a resolution of this Council of September 17th, with respect to improvement to the Horticultural grounds and Bowling greens, be reconsidered and rescinded.

Moved by Alderman Bridgman, seconded by Alderman Tolmie and resolved that the offer of Mr. Wm. Morden to repay the City the cost of improvements to Bowling Green at Horticultural Grounds, be accepted and the Superintendent of Works be and is hereby authorized to proceed with the work.

Communication dated September 21st, was received from Mr. A.C. Sutton, applying for reappointment as Solicitor for the City and enclosing references; offering to perform the work at a salary of \$100.00 per month.

Alderman Bridgman, one of the Special Committee appointed to look into the question of appointment of Solicitor, reported that the Committee after interviewing a number of Solicitors residing on the North Shore, had agreed upon Mr. A.A. Gray, who is prepared to attend to the work of Solicitor and provide

Senior Counsel, should such be required, at a salary at rate of \$1800.00 per year payable monthly.

Moved by Alderman Bridgman, seconded by Alderman Prior and resolved that Alexander Aitken Gray be appointed Solicitor for the City of North Vancouver at a salary of \$1800.00 per year, as from October 1st. Alderman Stoker not voting, by permission.

Moved by Alderman Bridgman, seconded by Alderman Townsley and resolved that Mr. A.C. Sutton be paid an Honorarium of one month's salary, owing to short notice.

Moved by Alderman Bridgman, seconded by Alderman Prior and resolved that the Mayor, Alderman Tolmie and the Clerk draft a letter of Agreement re Mr. Gray's appointment as Solicitor.

Moved by Alderman Bridgman, seconded by Alderman Irwin and resolved that an appropriation of \$50.00 out of Advertising funds of 2 1/2 % on brokers sales of City Tax Sale property, be authorized for advertising in the "Hook".

Moved by Alderman Irwin, seconded by Alderman Stoker and resolved that the Superintendent of Works be authorized to purchase and install one four inch Mueller pressure regulating valve, at an estimated cost of \$233.35 in connection with Tempe Heights water system extension, as per report of September 21st.

Moved by Alderman Irwin, seconded by Alderman Prior and resolved that the tender of Canadian Pipe Co. Ltd., for supplying 700 feet, 300 foot head and 475 feoot head water pipe, at the price of \$538.03, be accepted.

Moved by Alderman Bridgman, seconded by Alderman Townsley, and resolved that the Council do now adjourn. Whereupon the Council adjourned.
