

AMENDED CERTIFICATE OF RETURNING OFFICER

Result of Municipal Bye-Election held on the 27th day of May, A.D. 1925 on
“The North Vancouver Sawmills Limited, Fixed Assessment Bylaw, 1925”.

I, Rupert Foster Archibald, Returning Officer for the City of North Vancouver do hereby certify that as directed by the Municipal Council of the City of North Vancouver for the year 1925, I caused certified copies of Bylaw entitled “The North Vancouver Sawmills Limited, Fixed Assessment Bylaw, 1925” to be published and posted as required by law, together with notices appended thereto, stating that the said Bylaws would be submitted for a vote of the assent of the Electors of the City of North Vancouver, at 115 First Street East, North Vancouver, on Wednesday, the 27th day of May, 1925, between the hours of 9 o'clock a.m., and 7 o'clock p.m.

The said vote of the Electors of the said City of North Vancouver, was taken on the said day and resulted as follows:

“The North Vancouver Sawmills Limited, Fixed Assessment Bylaw, 1925”.

The votes in favor of said Bylaw not being at least three-fifths of the votes polled, exclusive of those rejected on any of the grounds specified in Section 78 of the “Municipal Elections Act” I declared the said Bylaw as not having received the assent of the Electors of the City of North Vancouver.

However, it having been discovered that said Bylaw required only a majority of the votes cast for and against said Bylaw under Section 218 of the “Municipal Act” I hereby certify that the said Bylaw received the assent of the Electors of the said City of North Vancouver.
