

CERTIFICATE OF RETURNING OFFICER

Result of Municipal Bye-Election to fill up the vacancy caused by the resignation of  
Alderman G.W. Vance, held on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1926

I, RUPERT FOSTER ARCHIBALD, Returning Officer for the City of North Vancouver do hereby certify that as directed by Statute I gave notice to the Electors of the City of North Vancouver on the 4th day of January 1926, as required by law, to the effect that nominations for the election of one person to represent the said Electors as Alderman to fill up the vacancy caused by the resignation of Alderman George Washington Vance, would be received by me at any time between the date of the Notice and 2 o'clock p.m., on Monday the 11<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1926, and that at the expiration of the time appointed for the Nomination of Candidates as aforesaid, more nominations were received than there were vacancies to be filled, and a poll became necessary, and such poll was granted by me and opened at 115 First Street East, on Thursday, January 14<sup>th</sup>, 1926, between the hours of 8 o'clock a.m. and 8 o'clock p.m., and that after the closing of the Poll, the votes were counted resulting as follows:

and that I forthwith declared JACK LOUDET duly elected as Alderman to fill up the unexpired portion of the term to which Alderman G.W. Vance had been elected, namely one year.
