

CERTIFICATE OF RETURNING OFFICER

Result of Municipal Election held on the 14th day of January A.D. 1926.

I, Rupert Foster Archibald, Returning Officer for the City of North Vancouver do hereby certify that as directed by the Municipal Council of the City of North Vancouver for the year 1925, I caused certified copies of Bylaws entitled "Burrard Dry Dock Fixed Assessment and Water Rates Exemption Bylaw, 1925", "North Vancouver Saw Mills Fixed Assessment and Water Rates Exemption Bylaw, 1925" and "Vancouver Dredging and Salvage Company Limited Fixed Assessment Bylaw, 1925" to be published and posted as required by law, together with notices appended thereto, stating that the said Bylaws would be submitted for a vote of the assent of the Electors of the City of North Vancouver, at 115 First Street East, North Vancouver, on Thursday, January 14th, 1926, between the hours of 8 o'clock a.m., and 8 o'clock p.m. The said vote of the Electors of the said City of North Vancouver, was taken on the said day and resulted as follows:
