Moved by Alderman Bridgman, seconded by Alderman Irwin and resolved that the whole matter be laid over until Monday evening.

The matter of sawdust nuisance was laid over until Monday night.

Mr. Hanes, City Engineer, requested leave of absence from Wednesday to Saturday.

Moved by Alderman Bridgman, seconded by Alderman Cartwright and resolved that Mr. Hanes be given whatever time he requires.

Moved by Alderman Bridgman, seconded by Alderman Loutet and resolved that this meeting of Council adjourn.
