## MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING OF COUNCIL, HELD ON THURSDAY, NOVEMBER $4^{TH}$ , 1926 AT 10:00 A.M.

Moved by Alderman Irwin, seconded by Alderman Townsley and resolved that the City Solicitor and Engineer meet the Harbour Board with a view to drafting a new agreement with respect to a low level road as outlined in letter from the Harbour Commissioners dated October 18<sup>th</sup>; also embodying the City Engineer's recommendations.

Moved by Alderman Irwin, seconded by Alderman Bridgman and resolved that the Harbour Board be advised that this year's Council is not in a position to guarantee future connection of Kennard Street in D.L. 272.

Moved by Alderman Bridgman, seconded by Alderman Irwin and resolved that the City retain the ownership o the slope from the north lien of the low level road to the south line of Park Street between St. David's Avenue and St. Patrick's Avenue.

Moved by Alderman Irwin, seconded by Alderman Townsley and resolved that Mayor Morden, Alderman Bridgman, Alderman Loutet and Alderman Irwin be a Committee to confer with the Engineer and solicitor in drafting a new agreement to give effect to proposed alterations in route of roadway.

Moved by Alderman Bridgman, seconded by Alderman Irwin and resolved that this meeting of Council adjourn, to reconvene at 4:30 p.m. on Friday, November 5<sup>th</sup> at the City Hall..
