An application was received from Third Street Garage, west of Lonsdale for permission to install an additional tank under the sidewalk for selling Ethel gasoline.

Moved by Alderman Bridgman, seconded by Alderman Cartwright and resolved that the above request be granted subject to the written approval of the City Engineer and Fire Chief.

Communication was received from the Secretary, retail Merchants Bureau, recommending that the Council stay proceedings with respect to proposed 27 foot roadway along the waterfront from St. David's connecting with the Esplanade at a point west of St. Patrick's Avenue and revert to the original agreement to open up Park Street.

Moved by Alderman Bridgman, seconded by Alderman Cartwright and resolved that the above communication be laid on the table.

Moved by Alderman Bridgman, seconded by Alderman Irwin and resolved that this Council do now proceed to resolve itself into Committee of the Whole.

Alderman Bridgman was appointed Chairman.
