

**MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING OF COUNCIL, HELD IN THE CITY HALL ON
THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 3RD, 1927 AT 4:30 P.M.**

Mayor Morden stated the reason for calling a Special Meeting was in connection with developments with respect to the slopes at the Low Level Road.

The Engineer was instructed to have photos taken showing a recent slide of the slope at the Low Level Road.
