## CERTIFICATE OF RETURNING OFFICER

## Result of Municipal Election held on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of January A.D. 1928.

I, RUPERT FOSTER ARCHIBALD, Returning Officer for the City of North Vancouver do hereby certify that as directed by Statute I gave notice to the Electors of the City of North Vancouver on the 30th day of December 1927, as required by the Law, to the effect that Nominations for the Election of persons to represent the said Electors as Mayor and Aldermen (3), and for the election of four persons to represent them as School Trustees, and for the election of one person to represent them as Police Commissioner, would be received by me at any time between the date of the Notice and 2 o'clock p.m., Monday, the 9<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1928, and that at the expiration of the time appointed for the Nomination of Candidates as aforesaid, only four Candidates namely Mrs. Jessie Cant, Marcus Servius McDowell, William Howard Parkin and William John Robertson were nominated for the office of School Trustee, and I forthwith declared the said Mrs. Jessie Can, Marcus Servius McDowell, William Howard Parkin and William John Robertson, elected as School Trustees for the ensuring term (23 years), and returned their names to the Clerk of the Municipality.

More nominations were received by me than there were vacancies to be filled, in the case of Mayor, Aldermen and Police Commissioner and a poll became necessary and such poll was granted by me and opened at 120 Esplande West, and at the Horticultural Hall, 22<sup>nd</sup> Street and Lonsdale Avenue, on Thursday, the12<sup>th</sup>, of January, 1928, between the hours of 8 o'clock a.m. and 8 o'clock p.m., and that after the closing of the Poll, the votes were counted resulting as follows:
