MINUTES OF THE ADJOURNED MEETING OF COUNCIL HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER, CITY HALL ON TUESDAY, DECEMBER 22, 1931 AT 4:30 P.M.

An agreement was submitted between the Government and the City in connection with Unemployment Relief work for a total sum of \$118,750.00 being a five percent reduction on the approved undertakings made at the request of the Federal Government who had notified the Province that the total of Municipal undertakings must not exceed a specific sum.

Revised schedules of work proposals in accordance with the aforementioned reduction and reductions in the proposed rates to be paid for the hire of teams with driver, truck drivers and Blacksmith's helper were called for.

Following the reading of the agreement clause by clause it was moved by Alderman Loutet, seconded by Alderman Brown and resolved that the agreement be and is hereby adopted, signed by the Mayor and City Clerk, and sealed with the Corporate Seal, and that application be made forthwith for the amount of the loan required for the City's share of the cost of the work under the terms of the agreement.

Moved by Alderman Anderson, seconded by Alderman Loutet, and resolved that the agreement with the necessary schedules be prepared and returned in tonight's mail, and that the Government be advised and the necessary notices published in the local press that Relief Work will be temporarily discontinued after Wednesday 23rd instant and only resumed when finances are available.

Moved by Alderman Anderson, seconded by Alderman Brown and resolved that this meeting of Council do now adjourn.

Whereupon the meeting adjourned at 5:10 p.m.
