Moved by Alderman Wilson seconded by Alderman Page and resolved that a Special Meeting of the Council be held in the City Hall on the afternoon of April 28, 1932 at 4.30 p.m., to further consider the Bylaw entitled "The City of North Vancouver General Borrowing and Hypothecation of Taxes Bylaw 1932" and any other competent business, at which every member of the Council and the Solicitor should be in attendance if possible.

Moved by Alderman Wilson seconded by Alderman Huggett and resolved that the Chairman of the Finance Committee take up with the local Management of the Royal Bank of Canada, the withdrawal of the Bank's letter of April 12<sup>th</sup> last, setting forth the terms on which a credit would be authorized, the contents of the letter not being acceptable to the Council.
