- Authorized the approval of Drawing No. K-8800/2301 of the B. C. Electric Railway Company showing proposed pole line construction on Forbes Avenue north of Third Street, said poles to be painted yellow 4 feet from the ground.
- Hearing was held to-day by the Registrar with regard to the petition of the Commissioner for the elimination of dividing lines between Lots and lanes in subdivisions 3 & 4, Block 229, D.L. 545 with the exception of Lots 6 to 11.
 Mr. W. N. Keeling appeared for the Commissioner.
 The Plan was approved and signed by the Registrar subject to Caveat re Succession and Probate Duties on the Easterly one acre of Lot 3, Block 229, D.L. 545. Subdivision Plan was registered to-day.
- 22nd Authorized that two Slow Signs be placed on the Low Level Road in the vicinity of the entrance to the Glaspie Lumber Company and the Japan Dock and that a suggestion be made to the Glaspie Lumber Company that Stop Signs be placed on their property so that all vehicles will stop before entering the Highway.
- The report of the North Vancouver Health Unit for the month of September was received and filed.
- 25th Authorized that Pass No. 67 issued to D. McDonald of the Greater Vancouver Water District be cancelled.
- A delegation comprising Messrs. Creelman, Doidge, Dale and Thomson representing the Schools and Football and Rugby Associations met the Commissioner with regard to the use of Mahon and Confederation Parks. It was decided to have as many practises as possible in Mahon Park to save Confederation Park for games, as Confederation Park is getting very badly cut up.
- 26th Authorized that the Central Christmas Cheer Committee be advised that similar assistance to what was given last year, will be given this year when required.
- Notified the B. A. Securities Limited that Item No. 12 - 1924 Ford Truck be struck off the Schedule attached to Railway Passenger's Assurance Company Policy No. 073737 and that 1928 Ford Panel, Engine and Serial No. C. A. 50270, License B.C. Cl-559 be substituted. This truck also to be insured for Public Liability and against fire.
- Granted permission to the North Shore Junior Football Club to use Mahon Park on Saturday and Wednesday afternoons until further notice.
- The Ferry Superintendent recommended that a new Art H. P. Cylinder be ordered for No. 3 Ferry at the price of \$800.00, same to be installed during the Annual overhaul.
 Authorized that the above recommendation be adopted.
- 27th Authorized that amended Drawing No. K-8800/2298 of the B. C. Electric Railway Company be approved with regard to erection of a pole on 17th Street west of Keith Road.
- Granted permission to R. J. Osman, 547-20th Street East to cut trees and brush on Lots 8 and 9, Block 11A, D. L. 550 adjoining his home, this permission being granted subject to sale and on the distinct understanding that all debris will be cleaned up and burned.
- 28th Received certified copy of Order-in-Council No. 1396 approving "The City of North Vancouver Tax Lands Sale By-law 1938, No. 10."
- Received certified copy of Order-in-Council No. 1397 approving "North Vancouver Street Traffic By-law 1923, Amendment By-law 1938, No. 2."
